What is Weatherization?

Weatherization means making cost-effective, energy-efficient upgrades to a home. These improvements will reduce energy usage while enhancing the home's comfort year-round.

Weatherization improvements may include:

- Insulation in attics, floors, & walls
- Furnace safety testing & repair or replacement
- Refrigerator replacement
- LED light bulbs retrofit
- Air sealing
- Air source heat pumps
- Solar photovoltaics
- Energy conservation education

How the Colorado Energy Office Weatherization Assistance Program Works

Free energy efficiency services are provided to income-qualified residents.

FOLLOW THESE SIMPLE STEPS



1. Obtain an application from your local provider (see reverse side of this brochure for provider list) and submit it.



2. When approved, the provider will schedule a free home energy audit to identify the most appropriate and cost-effective improvements for the home.



3. After the audit, the provider will schedule a qualified weatherization crew to install appropriate energy efficient upgrades.



4. A certified inspector will assess the completed work for quality.

How Do I Know If I Qualify?

Households may be eligible for weatherization services if they meet required income guidelines.

Receiving financial assistance from any of the following programs qualifies you for weatherization services:

- Low Income Energy Assistance Program (LEAP)
- Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)
- Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF)
- Aid to the Needy and Disabled (AND)
- Supplemental Security Income (SSI)

Can Renters Qualify?

If your landlord agrees, renters in single-family, multi-family, and manufactured home residences can qualify for free weatherization services.

Weatherization Q&A

Q: What if my home was weatherized in the past?

A: Homes that have participated in WAP within the past 15 years are not eligible for weatherization services.

Q: What is the purpose of the FREE home energy audit?

A: The FREE audit will determine the most cost-effective weatherization services for your home.

Q: How is quality weatherization work ensured?

A: The weatherization team is properly trained and equipped to adhere to quality assurance standards. A certified inspector will assess the work for quality and completion.

Q: Which housing types are eligible for weatherization services?

A: Single-family, multi-family, and manufactured homes can qualify for weatherization services.
